LA COLONIA RUSIÑOL

(ancient Can Remisa)

The origins can be traced back to 1845 when Josep Dulcet i Remisa bought the field and shortly after obtained the water rights in order to set up the business.

In 1880 the group passed to the Rusiñol family under the corporate name "Jaime Rusiñol Cotton Yarn and Woven Factory". When grandfather Rusiñol died, in 1887 the company passed to his grandchildren: Santiago (who in the long term would become one of the most prominent and recognized artists of Catalonia, mainly as a painter, but also as a writer, collector, journalist and playwright), Albert and Josep Maria. During the first years many reforms and extensions were made and the set acquired the present physiognomy. Within the Rusiñol Colony, in addition to the factory, there were: school, commissary, church, warehouses, garages and a number of

houses, some for the workers, others for the managers and executives, and also could not miss, the master's tower, the Cau Faluga.

The Cau Faluga dates from the year 1890. For many years it was not only the residence of the Rusiñol family, but a place to host literary events, the venue where the artist Santiago Rusiñol would organize stays with his friends, Ramon Casas and Enric Clarasó, and where his brother Albert would have relevant meetings and contacts

due to his status as a prestigious industrialist and politician.

The factory shut down in 1934 after being leased to several companies. The Colony was losing all its inhabitants (up to sixty people lived).

In 1940 the group was acquired by Llobet i Guri to take advantage of the hydroelectric power plant.

The current owners, Hilados Rusiñol S.A., bought it in 1980 to install a new spinning mill, which worked until 2009, being the last in the middle Ter to close. The entire Colony has recently undergone a major restoration, notably the Cau Faluga, which after many years of abandonment and in a shabby state of conservation,

offering a new activity in one of the most important buildings of the industrial heritage of Catalonia.




